An exciting opportunity exists as a full-time research technician in the Laboratory of Prof. Eicke Latz. The Latz laboratory is dedicated to uncovering the fundamental mechanisms of innate immune activation that play a crucial role in autoinflammatory, rheumatologic and chronic inflammatory diseases. In this role you will be supporting the histology experiments of lab members in their projects as well as fulfilling typical laboratory tasks including managing lab stocks and reagents and maintaining lab databases. This position would suit someone who is highly organised, accurate in their experimentation and adaptable to learning new techniques.

Primary responsibilities

- Preparation and processing of animal histological samples, including organ embedding, cutting and slide staining.
- Organization of lab stocks and sample/reagent database management
- Cell culture, including cell line creation (i.e., CRISPR knockouts and overexpression models), innate immune stimulation assays and isolation and culture of primary human blood cells.
